Operating Procedure for the UWRA Volunteering Committee:

This committee encourages volunteering in the community and on campus. It also provides oversight of the School Partnership Program, which encourages financial support through the Foundation for Madison Public School. The committee also coordinates the bi-annual selection process Dane County food pantries.

The UWRA Volunteer Committee met once in 2018-2019 to determine the food pantry selections for the upcoming two-year cycle. The food pantries are: Grace Episcopal, UW-Madison Open Seat, Mt. Zion Baptist Church, and Fritz Food Pantry (Goodman Community Center).

The UWRA continues to match year, members contributions to public schools with a special grant. Once the contributions reported to the UWRA office reach \$1,000.00, the Association will donate \$1,000.00 to the Foundation for Madison Public Schools.

The members are recommending a broader focus on partnerships and engagement.

The committee recommended disbanding the Volunteering Committee to the Board of Directors. The committee felt the Board of Directors are able to provide the limited work of the committee. Disbanding the committee was approved.
