# WEA Trust: No Longer Available 12/31/22



Members currently enrolled in WEA Trust must select a new health plan during open enrollment

- Access Plan
- Medicare Plus
- State Maintenance Plan (SMP)

- WEA Trust East
- WEA Trust West Chippewa
- WEA Trust West Mayo



Members who do not select a new health plan during open enrollment will not have coverage for 2023



#### **New Access Vendor: Dean**



**Dean Health Plan** will be the new **Access Plan** vendor effective January 1, 2023

Applies to both Access and Access HDHP



Provides coverage in every county in Wisconsin and nationwide

Also provides worldwide out-of-network coverage



To continue current coverage, members **must** enroll during open enrollment



#### **New SMP Vendor: Dean**



**Dean Health Plan** will be the new **State Maintenance Plan** vendor effective
January 1, 2023



Providers in: Florence, Marquette, Waupaca, and Waushara counties



Contact Dean Health Plan with all SMP coverage questions

#### What is SMP?

Standard supplementary option counties that do not:

- Have at least one health plan with premium rates that are classified as Tier 1 or in the lowest annual premium rate threshold
- Satisfy all provider access qualifications established by ETF

# New Medicare Plus Vendor: UnitedHealthcare





UnitedHealthcare (UHC) will be the new Medicare Plus vendor effective January 1, 2023



Medicare Plus provides coverage in every county in Wisconsin and worldwide



To continue current coverage, members **must** enroll during open enrollment

- UHC will continue to offer IYC Medicare Advantage separately
- No impact to IYC Medicare Advantage members or benefits

### **Medical Benefit Changes**



Minor medical benefit changes for plan year 2023



Health plans may waive prior authorization for remote patient monitoring when appropriate

# Medical Benefit Changes - Continued



Separate behavioral therapy sessions for a patient's immediate family are now allowed as part of an ongoing mental health and/or substance use disorder treatment plan

- Terry meets with a therapist and establishes a treatment plan for anxiety
- Terry's spouse can now meet with Terry's therapist separately to provide feedback on treatment plan progress
- Terry and their spouse can also meet jointly with the therapist to discuss Terry's treatment plan

#### All wellness incentives are considered taxable income

#### **2023 Rates**

#### **Non-Medicare Premiums**

- Statewide average premium increased 4.2% for 2023
  - HMO Premium changes range from 0.9% to 6.3% for existing plans
  - No rate comparison for new plans/service areas
    - Dean Prevea360 West is a "new" service area
  - Access Plan premium went down 6.4%
    - New vendor
    - Had been trending down with WEA

#### **Medicare Premiums**

- IYC Medicare Advantage
  - 3.3% Premium decrease for 2023
  - 18.7% decrease since 2021
- Medicare Plus
  - 1.9% increase for 2023
- Health Plan Medicare
  - Average 9.1% increase for 2023

#### Flu Pneumonia Covid-19 Tetanus

- for injury or exposure Hepatitis B
  - for members at medium or high risk of hepatitis

Shingles
Meningitis
Travel Vaccines
Tetanus

- for preventive use Hepatitis A and Hepatitis B
  - for members at low risk

#### Part D Vaccines Received at Doctor's Office

 Medicare member receives a Part D vaccination in medical providers office

Member will pay the full price of that vaccine to the medical provider

 Member can then file a Prescription Drug Claims Form to Navitus to recoup their vaccine payment

 Navitus will only repay the Medicare Part D pharmacy rate for the vaccine.

# Part D Vaccines Doctor's Office Example

- Medicare member gets Shingrix vaccine at doctor's office at a cost of \$350
- Member pays doctor's office \$350 out of pocket and files a Prescription Drug Claims Form to Navitus for full amount
- Navitus's pharmacy Medicare Part D pharmacy rate for the Shingrix is \$150
- Member will NOT be reimbursed the \$200 difference

# Part B Vaccines at Pharmacies

- Member can present their Red/White/Blue Medicare card at a pharmacy
- Pharmacies should be able to bill Medicare Part B directly/electronically
- No claim submission needed

Open enrollment is **September 26** – **October 21, 2022**. Any changes made during this period will be effective January 1, 2023. Make the most of open enrollment:



- Consider supplemental benefits such as dental insurance, vision insurance or Accident Plan.





#### **Health Plan Search**




- Visit the Health Plan Search for <u>State</u> or <u>Local</u> Employees & Retirees to access provider directories
- Two ways to use:
  - Find desired health plan network in alphabetical list
  - Use filters to narrow down your search
    - If searching by county, click on the county name dropdown that appears when typing
- Click on health plan network name to view more details

#### **Transitioning Care**

If you are currently receiving treatment for a chronic condition or have prior authorizations into 2023:

- Enroll in a new health plan before October 21, 2022
- In early November, you may contact your new provider or health plan to begin the transition process
  - Your current provider may work with the new plan or provider to ensure continued care
- Continue with your current treatment plan with WEA through the end of 2022
